'What is offence?': HC to cops on those who sheltered Tablighis

NEW DELHI, NOVEMBER 12 THE DELHI High Court Friday

auestioned the Delhi Police for registering FIRs against Indian nationals who had provided accommodation in their homes or mosques to attendees of the Tablighi Jamaat congregation at Markaz Nizamuddin during the lockdown last year, asking whether there was any notification to throw people out instead.

'Suddenly a lockdown is imposed, where does one go? On the street? He will remain where he is. What is the offence committed? Is there any bar on residents of Madhya Pradesh to come and stay in Delhi or stay in any temple, masjid, gurdwara," said Justice Mukta Gupta, while hearing the petitions seeking quashing of FIRs against Delhi residents who are accused of allowing the attendees – mostly foreign nationals – to live in mosques or their houses.

The court said that when the lockdown was imposed, the people were in the mosque and nobody could go anywhere.

'There was no means available. Then what is the offence? What is the violation? Or was there any notification that everybody will throw out whosoever is staying somewhere," it added.

The counsel representing the Delhi Police told the court that the investigating officer of the cases has recently changed and sought time to file a detailed status report. The court, while listing the case for hearing on December 6, said one more opportunity is granted to file the status report within one week. It also asked the police to verify

whether there are residential places or rooms within the mosques

"Wherever anybody was residing, person need(ed) to continue. A person could not even shift if they were with their grandparents, parents... nobody could go out of the house. Wherever you were, you were just suddenly static. So, there was no question of changing the place at that time," said Justice Gupta further. "When the lockdown was imposed, there was no bar on anybody residing over there," continued the court.

Ashima Mandla, representing the accused, told the court that the police in the chargesheet have placed two prohibitory orders of March 24 and March 30 but in status report they are referring to a prohibitory order of March 11.

"A bare perusal of those prohibitory orders... It only bars a religious congregation and in FIRs itself, the allegation is that I am simply residing. At no point in FIR, they say that a religious congregation is being held despite lockdown," she submitted.

Mandla further submitted that police shoved and packed people like sardines in quarantine centres. "Out of these FIRs, there are three FIRs which are peculiar because those are the FIRs where private persons have been made accused over here for just giving refuge in their own houses. It is not even the case of a Masjid," she contended, adding that women are not allowed to stay inside the Markaz and they stay in private houses.

At least 48 people are accused in at least a dozen FIRs, which are under challenge before the HC.

mental official Rameshwar Prasad Gupta had said in New Delhi, the week before the United Nations climate summit at Glasgow, known as COP26.

During the crucial talks, a fundamental question remains: Will there be enough "carbon space" in the atmosphere for India's developmental needs to coexist with the global ambition of limiting warming to 1.5 degrees Celsius (2.7 degrees Fahrenheit) since pre-industrial times.

Last week, Prime Minister Narendra Modiannounced that the country would aim to stop adding greenhouse gases to the atmosphere by 2070 – two decades after the US, and at least 10 years later than China. But this will only shave off a tenth of a degree of the world's warming, said climate scientist Niklas Hohne of the NewClimate Institute and the Climate Action Tracker.

And India's short-term targets for 2030 – increasing its current capacity of non-fossil fuel electricity to 500 gigawatts and using green energy to meet half of its needs, cutting carbon emissions by a billion tons compared with previous targets, and reducing the carbon intensity of its economy by 45% – wouldn't have any impact, said Hohne.

But experts said these goals are ambitious for India, considering its developmental status and will be far from easy.

For instance, India will have to triple its non-fossil fuel capacity in less than a decade. And for that, its power sector will have to completely reimagine itself. States, whose entire economies have centred around coal for centuries, will have to diversify. Land, which is in short supply in the crowded subcontinent, will theirtime. be required for sprawling solar parks."It's a humongous task for a country like India," said Sandeep Pai, who studies energy security and climate change at the Center for Strategic and International Studies in Washington, DC. Even then, it may not be enough for the world. Despite their "net zero" mate finance."

And because of its vast population, India's energy choices have an oversized impact for the world.There are 27 million peoplewithout access to electricity. It has roads and homes to build, while extreme heat is driving up the demand for air conditioning. To fulfil these needs, India will need to build a power system the size of the entire European Union's.

Although India accounts for the most annual emissions after China and the US, its negotiators in Glasgow have, time and again, pointed out that they have historically contributed a fraction of the world's emissions. Indian environment and climate change minister Bhupender Yadav told the Associated Press in an interview Wednesday it's a matter of "conscience" and said those countries historically responsible for emissions need to keep their unfulfilled promise of providing climate finance.

Modi said earlier at the summit that India expected the world's developed nations to make \$1 trillion available as climate finance. As things stand right now, the climate finance from rich nations to align with the 1.5 degrees Celsius target is "nowhere to be seen", said Chirag Gajjar, a climate expert at the World Resources Institute.

It's possible for the goal of 1.5 degrees and India's development needs to coexist, said climate scientist Hohne. What is key, he said, is not building any new coal-fired power plants anywhere in the world, including India, and shutting "some coal-fired power plants" before

A transition away from coal, especially for coal-dependent regions, would require the assistance of the international community, Hohne said.

अश्विन को अतीत में इंडियन प्रीमियर लीग के दौरान गेंदबाजी छोर पर जोस बटलर को रन आउट करने को खेल भावना के खिलाफ बताते हुए आलोचना झेलनी पड़ी है। गंभीर के ट्वीट के जवाब में किसी ने लिखा. 'आपका नजरिया सही नहीं है।'

इस पर अश्विन ने टिप्पणी कि, 'उनका मानना है कि अगर वह सही था तो यह भी सही है। अगर वह गलत था तो यह भी गलत है। निष्पक्ष मूल्यांकन?' भारत के इस अनुभवी स्पिनर ने वार्नर को टैग करते हुए लिखा, 'वार्नर ने अद्भुत शाट खेला था। शानदार शाट।' वार्नर ने इस मैच में 30 गेंद में तीन चौके और इतने ही छक्के की मदद से 49 रन की पारी खेली। मैथ्यू वेड ने 19वें ओवर में लगातार तीन छक्के लगाकर टीम को पांच विकेट से जीत दिला दी।
