A win away from bronze

Grappler Aman lost to Japan's Rei Higuchi, but beating Puerto Rico's Darian Cruz will get him a podium finish

TWO EASY wins to begin the day and and no points conceded - Aman Sehrawat, India's selection for the 57 kg men's freestyle category at the Paris Olympics may have thought that his confidencebuilding run would take him into the gold medal bout. But Japan's Rei Higuchi, from the famed Nippon Sport Science University, has his own ambitions, especially after what happened before the Tokyo Olympics.

The Japanese wrestler had moved back to the 57 kg weight category in 2021, after a brief period at-

tempting to become the No1 in his country in the 65 kg category. But at the Asian Olympic Qualifiers Almaty, Higuchi missed weight by a mere 50 grams. Japan then sent Yuki Takahashi to the World Olympic Qualifiers, and he

returned home to beat Higuchi to make the cut for the Tokyo Games. Higuchi won a silver medal in the 57 kg category at the

2023 World Championships in Belgrade and had made it clear that in his second Olympics appearance, he was looking to go one better than the silver he earned in Rio.

Aman fell victim to the Japanese's rampant run at these Olympics, losing via technical superiority 10-0 inside two minutes. But the Indian still has the chance to take a bronze medal home, if he can beat Puerto Rican wrestler Darian Cruz - who had lost 12-2 to Higuchi.

Aman had started his Paris Olympics campaign brightly, taking down 2022 European Champion Vladimir Egarov immediately at the start of their bout. He then took advantage of a passivity warning on the North Macedonian to quickly put together another takedown to lead 4-0, a score that quickly grew to 6-0 after Egarov stepped out of bounds once and was also penalised for passivity.

The second period saw Aman immediately avoid a grab on one of his legs and then swooped down and got a hand on Egarov's left ankle. He didn't let go and quickly converted that to two more points to lead by 8.

The first match of his day was quickly brought to a close thereafter. A weighty push from the top, followed by a swift move to the back and Aman had the last two points he needed to complete a win through technical superiority.

Jamaica miss men's final, US lead the way

His second win of the day though, was a performance that not many saw coming. Zelimkhan Abakarov, a Chechen wrestler who represents Albania, was the Indian's next challenge and a tough one at that. Abakarov won the 2022 World Championships in the 57 kg category and then won bronze the year after at the Worlds, but for Aman, the real worry would have been that he had lost last year to him by technical superiority.

A minute into the cagey start and the referee asked the Albanian to ramp up his efforts. Soon the 30-second passivity timer started and Aman capitalised. He moved low and grabbed his opponent's left foot and immediately landed the takedown to put two points on the board to add to the

locked the Albanian's legs in a lace and then starte to roll. He managed to turn his helpless opponer three times for the score to be 11-0 in his favou Abakarov's camp challenged the call, lost and gav up another point for their troubles.

Anshu out

A tough opening match for 57 kg women freestyle wrestler Anshu meant that her chance winning a Paris Olympics medal needed a legendar run. But the Indian, who won a silver medal at th 2021 World Championships, couldn't match th pedigree of USA's Helen Louis Maroulis, a multiple time Olympic medallist across different weight ca egories

Malik was unable to land a takedown on th stout defence of the American in the first period who held onto the Indian's hands and kept any hopes of a takedown firmly locked within her grip. Up 2-0, Maroulis completely shut down Malik in the second period, stitching together a takedown and then rolling the 23-year-old from Jind, Harvana. Malik got a takedown of her own soon after but the clock ran down on her and she lost 7-2. Maroulis then lost to Japan's Tsugami Sakurai in the semi-final to end any hopes of a medal through the repechage for the Indian.

Don't have any more strength: Vinesh retires

VINESH PHOGAT went to sleep desolate. letting the world know that she'd hung up her wrestling boots with a short middle-of-the-night announcement on social media.

"Ma, kushtee mere se jeet gayi, main haar gayi. Maaf karna, aapka sapna, meri himmat sab toot chukein. Isse zyada taqat nahi rahi ab. Alvida kushtee 2001-2024 (Ma, wrestling has won, I have lost. Please forgive me, your dreams and my courage, everything is shattered. I don't have any more strength now. Goodbye wrestling 2001-2024)," Phogat said in a post on X, adding that she would always be indebted to all.

When she woke up, the wrestler had a surprise visitor: Abhinav Bindra. "I had

to meet her because she is my hero," Bindra, independent India's first individual gold medallist at the Olympics, told The Indian Express.

Phogat was one win away from joining Bindra in the exclusive club of India's individual gold medallists -- Neeraj Chopra is the only other member. On the morning of her Olympic final on Wednesday, however, she could not meet the weight criteria and was disqualified for being 100 grams

overweight. Her day of triumph turned into torment.

Bindra reached the Athletes' Village with a bouquet and a message, and extracted a smile out of her -- the first time she smiled "dil se" (from the heart), one of Phogat's team members said.

In a post on X, he paid tribute to

sustainable Green

Phogat's resilience. "Through you, we are learning what it means to never lose the fight in us, even as a loss weighs heavily. You embody the true spirit of a warrior," he wrote.

"Not all victories look alike. Some end up as a glittering souvenir in a cabinet but the ones that matter more find their way into the stories we tell our children. And every child in this country will know the champion you are. Every child will grow up wanting to face life with the resilience you have displayed. I thank you for

that." he wrote. Phogat's team has filed an appeal in the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS), urging it to take a considerate view and challenge the competition rules, saying she wasn't awarded even a silver medal

despite making it to the final in a fair manner. The outcome of the appeal is pending. Bindra wasn't the only one to offer

support to Phogat. American wrestler Sarah Hildebrandt, who Phogat was supposed to wrestle for the gold medal, also expressed solidarity.

Speaking after winning the 50-kg final on Wednesday, Hildebrandt said she "felt for her". "She had an amazing day yesterday (Tuesday), did an insane feat (beating the undefeated Japanese Yui Susaki) and you know, I don't think she saw that happening in an Olympics like that... So, for sure, my heart goes out for her. I think she's an amazing competitor, an amazing wrestler in person. It sucks, but also, at the end of the day, this is definitely part of the job and we all pledge to get it done, as shitty as it is, she said.

India's Aman lost to Japan's Rei Higuchi in their men's freestyle 57kg semifinal on Thursday. AP

THE UNITED States took the first, convincing step towards ending their men's 24-year Olympic sprint relay drought when they qualified fastest from Thursday's heats, with more firepower to come, but Jamaica crashed out after poor changeovers.

The U.S. women's team also look well placed to reclaim the title from Jamaica after qualifying fastest, despite a changeover scare.

For a nation that routinely fields multi-finalists in the men's individual sprints and who dominated the sprint relay for decades, the U.S.'s travails in the last 30 years are nothing short of mind-numbing. They have not won Olympic gold since 2000 and their only medal is a silver in Athens 20 years ago when their stellar team came up 100th of a second short of Britain.

They did cross the line second in 2012 but were stripped of the title due to a doping offence by Tyson Gay

Since 1995, in the Olympics and World Championships, they are in double figures for dropped batons, disqualifications or bans.

They did get the baton round in the last two worlds, taking silver in 2022 and gold last year, and have 15 Olympic golds in the event – 13 more than anyone else - but those medals are all looking a little dusty.

Noah Lyles and Kenny Bednarek, who went in the men's 200 semi-finals on Wednesday and race the final later on Thursday, were understandably absent from Thursday's heats.

However, former world champion Christian Coleman, making his first appearance of the Games, set them on their way well.

Fred Kerley, who was in-

volved in the botched changeover that ended their Tokyo hopes, ran a strong second leg, handing to green-haired Kyree King, and Courtney Lindsey brought them home well clear in 37.47 seconds.

Akani Simbini ran a storming last leg to take South Africa to second in 37.94, just ahead of Britain (38.04), the silver medallists in Tokyo who were subsequently stripped of their medals following a doping offence by CJ Ujah.

A slick China won the second heat in 38.24 and France were roared to second in 38.34 but Jamaica, champions in 2012 and 2016, messed up two changeovers to finish fourth and miss out on Friday's final.

In-form quartet

The U.S. women took gold ahead of their big rivals in 2012 and 2016 but were knocked back into second in Tokyo.

Jamaica, however, are shorn of the superstars who brought them home three years ago, while the U.S. were able to field an immensely powerful and in-form quartet. Melissa Jefferson (third in the 100), Twanisha Terry (fifth in the 100), Gabby Thomas (200 gold medallist) and Sha'carri Richardson (silver in the 100) made up Thursday's team, the last three having won gold at the worlds last year.

They sailed close to the wind with the second changeover as Terry struggled to catch Thomas, losing considerable ground to Germany, which Richardson duly made up with a terrific last leg as they qualified fastest in 41.94 seconds.

Britain made it through as winners of the second heat in 42.03 and will be considerably strengthened by the return of Dina Asher-Smith and Daryll Neita for the final.

Centre's databank of independent directors fails to find any takers

RECENTLY, THE GOVERN-MENT-RUN Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs (IICA) held a discussion with a group of leading executives search firms to strengthen the boards of Indian companies.

The key point of the discussion was to give companies and headhunting firms free access to the IICA's databank for independent directors.

However, when *FE* spoke to the executive search firms, a majority of them said that they don't use the databank currently if they have to search for independent directors for their client companies.

"We don't use IICA's database. We handpick people based on the client's specifications. We have our own network of CXOs who we tap when there's a need to appoint an independent director.

"I don't need database but it can be a good supplement for companies and search firms," said head of a firm who was part of the discussion, on con-



dition of anonymity.

Another executive search firm head said that his firm has not been using the data bank because it's not being updated in real time.

"We have been using our own headhunting network to search for independent directors just as we search professionals for other roles. If the databank can provide qualitatively better information, it can be useful," said Ronesh Puri, managing director at Executive Access.

Launched in 2019, IICA's independent director databank is a comprehensive repository of both existing independent directors as well

as individuals eligible and willing to be appointed as independent directors. To become an independent director, a person has to register with this databank in addition to clearing an online proficiency selfassessment test. The databank has about 22,000 directors including 6,000 plus women directors, as per IICA's website.

At present, executive search firms in India are either using

their own network or some private databases to fill up positions of independent directors as and when required. "Despite offering the biggest pool of directors, the IICA's databank is never a first port of call for the companies. It's not about quantity but the quality of information that's more important. In fact, many companies are not even aware that such a databank exists," said partner at another search firm.

Experts said that if maintained properly, the databank can be effective in diversifying the current base, and give a chance to companies to induct talented people from different backgrounds.

Major reservoirs at 65% of capacity



Bountiful monsoon rains have boosted water levels in the country's 50 major reservoirs, consistently for six weeks, reports Sandip Das. For the first time in the last one year, water levels in dams stood above the previous year level (up 7%) on Thursday, compared to a week ago when it was down 6% on year. These reservoir levels are 21% above the last ten-years average. According to the **Central Water**

Commission's (CWC) weekly bulletin, the reservoir capacity is filled up to 65% currently, while a week ago, water levels were up to 51% of capacity. Especially in the south (42 dams) and east (23 dams), dams are filled up 24% and 11% more than the previous years respectively thanks to adequate monsoon rains. Dams in southern states currently have 77% capacity filled, as per CWC, which is an improvement from 66% a week back.

WITH MORE STATES opening up or facilitating trade of agricultural commodities on the government's electronic – National Agriculture Market (e-NAM), trade on the pan-India digital wholesale platform crossed ₹23,523 crore duringApril-JulyofFY25,up13% on year.

Sources told FE that there has also been a significant spike in inter-mandi and inter-state trading of agri-commodities on the digital platform, which currently integrates 1,389 mandis across 27 states.

In the last five years, trade on the digital wholesale market run by the agriculture ministry has increased by 124% last fiscal from ₹34,940 crore in 2019-20. The platform reported sales of ₹78,424 crore in FY24.
